For example, in the Chicago Manual of Style, putting dialogue in the middle of paragraphs depends on the context. As in the above example, if the dialogue is a natural continuation of the sentences that come before, it can be included in your paragraph. The major caveat is if someone new speaks after that, you start a new paragraph and indent it.

Use a comma between the dialogue and the tagline (the words used to identify the speaker, or "he said/she said"): "I would like to go to the beach this weekend," she told him as they left the apartment.

How to write dialogue: Keep it tight and avoid any unnecessary words. Move the action of the scene forward. Keep it oblique, where characters never quite answer each other directly. Reveal character dynamics and emotions. Keep speeches short. Ensure characters use their own voice. Add intrigue.

To let readers know which character is speaking, use the dialogue tag "said" by placing a comma inside the quotation marks, then giving the attribution for who is speaking. You also can use punctuation to add realism to your dialogue.

You should place the quotation marks at both ends on your dialogue that you are referring to. It is the quotation marks that differentiate the quote from other sentences in your essay. Use single quotation marks inside the double quotes. This applies in the case of dialogue inside a quote.

Put simply, dialogue is narrative conveyed through speech by two or more characters. Effective dialogue should do many things at once, not just convey information. It should set the scene, advance action, give insight into each character, and foreshadow future dramatic action.

Most dialogue sentences are made of two parts: the dialogue, which is the spoken portion of the sentence, and then the dialogue tag, which identifies the speaker. In this example, we have the following sentence, spoken by Martha. "I am going to the zoo," said Martha. The sentence which Martha speaks is the dialogue.

Use simple dialogue tags. Fancy dialogue tags like she denounced or he proclaimed might seem like a good way to show off your writer's vocabulary, but in truth they draw attention away from your dialogue. She said or he said is almost always your best choice. Let the characters' words speak for themselves.

### **Writing Dialogue: How to Write Dialogue in a Story ...**

In your references list at the end of your paper, provide your readers with the full citation of the book you took the dialogue from. Include the name of the author, followed by his initials. Give the year of the book's publication in parentheses. Provide the title of the work, the location and name of the publisher.
